

CMVA Prairie Chapter William F. Eckert Memorial Bursary Deadline to Apply: October 1st

Policy

- 1. The Prairie Chapter has one \$1000 bursary per year to be awarded in 2014 going forward. Chapter members are invited to request a revision at any Chapter Meeting to change the amount of the bursary and/or the number of bursaries to be awarded.
- The bursary shall be open to any resident in the Prairie Chapter Region attending a university, college, or other technical institution in Prairie Provinces who is enrolled in a program of training for an engineering or industrial trade, which could or does now utilize industrial vibration and/or condition monitoring technologies.
- 3. The rating criteria shall be as follows:
 - a) Child or spouse of a current CMVA Prairie Chapter member or a current chapter member. (5 points);
 - b) Expression of interest/previous experience in the field of machinery vibration analysis (VA) and GPA or average mark. This would require the candidate to write a brief description of their work experience in VA or their interest in VA. (The work experience and "interest in VA" should provide an indication of the candidate's knowledge and experience in VA and can be rated by the individual reviewers, also the reviewer may or may not want to use the GPA/average mark) (1-10 points).
- 4. There shall be a committee comprised of a chairperson and the chapter executive. All members of the committee will review the applicants and rate the candidates individually, send their results to the chairperson who will then tabulate the results and award the bursaries. The committee will make recommendations of ranked finalists to the Chapter's Executive Committee which will vote on a final decision.
- 5. The deadline date for the chairperson to receive completed applications will be October 1, each year, so the bursary award winner can be announced at our Chapter Fall AGM. Winners are expected to be enrolled as full-time students in the following academic year.
