Old Business

Treasurers Report

- It was estimated the expenses for the Mini Conference was at \$1600 but the chapter should break even for the expense.

Mini Conference

A discussion was held on the following points:

 - There will be a need for further support / help towards the conference next year.

2. Feedback:

- There was good feedback on the email registration for the conference;
- Would have been more in attendance if there weren't as many station outages/shutdowns in progress. This should be a consideration towards booking a date next time.
- Bruce Cameron mentioned that he would like to see more vendors in relation to bearings and gearboxes.
- Jesse suggested hosting the conference as a Bi-Annual event;



- It was considered that there was a good mix of vendor and technical presentations.

 John Sherrard suggested that it would be good to have more Case Studies.
- Good feedback was received on the social event held Tuesday night, suggested hotel with catering next time around to attract more individuals.
- Surveys are to be sent out to the members and vendors to see what was liked and disliked for the conference.

3. Financing future events;

- Jesse petitioned the chapter members' thoughts on discontinuing the Student Bursary program (\$1,000.00) in order to re-direct the funds to chapter technical initiatives and training.
- Members felt as though the bursary program should stay.
- Bruce Cameron motioned to keep the \$1,000 bursary program, all CMVA members were in favor, none opposed.
- There was a discussion on Academic Ambassador program asking members to step-up and reach out to students to increase student membership.
- George Cameron suggested reaching out to businesses, and extend the invitation to non-members for technical courses.

4. ISO Accreditation:

5. CMVA Web Site:

- Sneak peek into rebranding of the CMVA, new colours for logo
- Delivery date was originally set for July but has been pushed out 2-3 months
